POLICIES RELATING TO TUITION AND FEE PAYMENTS

Below is the financial policy of Bethel Christian Academy. Each parent is asked to read and sign the policy each year to indicate his understanding of an agreement with the policy. Any special financial or payment arrangements must be requested in writing and approved by the administration.

- 1) Bethel Christian Academy does not have any supplemental funding; therefore all fees and tuition must be paid on a timely basis.
- 2) All tuition payments and fees are due on the first of each term. After the tenth of the month, a late fee of UGX 25, 000 will be charged to the account. A reminder will be mailed showing a late charge to the account.
- 3) Unpaid balances cannot be carried over to the second month. Parents who do not pay after 14 school days will be notified that their children are not to attend classes. In addition, there will be a financial hold on all report cards, transcripts, and other school records if payment is not current at the end of each grading period. This financial hold will remain in effect until the account is current.
- 4) There will be a UGX 50,000 returned check fee on all returned checks, regardless of the reason for the return.
- 5) All fees other than tuition are non-refundable and non-transferable. Tuition is **non-refundable** if the student has been to school any day during the term, or if the student drops out without proper notification. An exception may be made if the account has been paid in full for the school year.
- 6) Workbooks and school equipment: Workbooks are ordered each year by the school at a cost which is communicated in June of each year, including shipping cost. Parents should pay for the workbooks by July each year to enable planning and ordering. Parents have the option to order workbooks on their own. Some textbooks are supplied at no charge and will be distributed by the class teacher and must be returned by the end of the year.
- 7) If a student damages or loses a non-consumable text book, a fee will be assessed to cover replacement of the book. Students will be expected to pay for repair of school property and equipment, if damage was deliberately caused by a student.
- 8) Parents are ultimately responsible for all payments.

NON-PAYMENT OF TUITION OR OTHER SCHOOL FEES

In the event of withdrawal, transfer, or expulsion, the parents are responsible for full payment of tuition and other fees. Full payment of tuition and other fees must be made through the end of the term. The Bethel Christian Academy reserves the right to withhold report cards and student records until tuition and other fees have been paid in full. By signing the student handbook agreement, the initial application for enrolment, or an application for re-enrolment, you are authorizing the school to withhold report cards and other records until tuition and other fees have been paid in full.

STUDENT CONDUCT

Student Code of Conduct (The following to be signed by each student entering grades 4-12)

High standards of conduct are required of all those associated with Bethel Christian Academy. BCA expects that its students live above reproach showing respect to God, country, family, faculty, and fellow students. Therefore, lying, cheating, theft, and profanity will not be tolerated. Constructive suggestions are welcome, but griping will not be tolerated.

A student living in violation of one of the aforementioned standards displays an area of need in his life. A teacher or administrator aware of the need may therefore point out the problem to the student and communicate the sphere of concern to the parents. At that time, those involved in counseling may consider it necessary to discharge some form of discipline to help the student mature in the given area. If the problem persists, more severe discipline may be in order. Anyone who will not cooperate spiritually, morally, or scholastically will be required to withdraw.

CLASSROOM RULES

Although each teacher will have specific classroom procedures that he expects to have followed in the room, as a school-wide standard, we expect adherence to these basic rules:

- 1. The student should not speak out in class without first securing permission from the teacher.
- 2. The student should not leave his seat without permission.
- 3. The student should always give the teacher his full attention while he is teaching.
- 4. The student should always address and reply to the teacher with respect. All students are to address adults as Mr., Mrs., or Miss; never by first name. Out of respect for the administration and faculty, we ask the parents to set the example in this regard when speaking with or about the school personnel.
- 5. Negative attitudes and responses will not be tolerated.
- 6. The student should not engage in running, shoving, yelling, and other boisterous behavior or "horse-play" inside the buildings or during inappropriate times outdoors.
- 7. No "bullying" or mistreatment of fellow classmates.

Any student not complying with the above standards is subject to immediate removal from class, and any student consistently in conflict with any policy of the school will be asked to withdraw.

Bethel Christian Academy uses both positive and negative discipline to instill in students behavior patterns and attitudes that will produce self-disciplined lives. Discipline is administered in love as a preventive or corrective measure, and each student is dealt with according to his grade level.
